

Infants-Spring Term 2019

RE:

Our topics are: Christmas, Revelation, Lent and Holy Week.

English:

Children are taught phonics daily in accordance with government recommendations. We follow the National Curriculum for English. Your child will experience reading and writing in different genres including narrative, non-fiction and poetry.

Mathematics:

We are following the National Curriculum for Mathematics covering number work, shape and space, measures, data handling and time. We teach problem solving through all these topics.

Science:

We are covering the topics:
Everyday materials and Scientists and Inventors. In each topic the children will have opportunities for observation, investigation and experimentation.

ICT:

We are experimenting with graphic software to create images relating to our Geography and Art topics. We will also be developing the children's programming skills through the topic 2Go. We also use the internet and iPads to support teaching and learning throughout the curriculum.

Geography:

Island Homes.
Through this topic the children will be investigating the island of St. Lucia.

Music:

Year 1: Musical School: In this topic the children explore sounds and learn how to create different effects on percussion instruments.
Year 2: The children will be continuing to learn to play the recorder.

Art:

Food around the world
Linking our art work to our Topic we will explore the elements of colour, line and shape, tone and pattern; using the disciplines of observational drawing and painting.

DT:

Sewing
The children will learn to stitch and use their sewing skills to produce an egg cosy.

PE:

Gymnastic and games programmes will help children develop agility, balance and coordination. Multi skills will be developed through games lessons. Please provide a tracksuit until the weather gets warmer.

PSCHE:

We are covering the topics: Goals and Dreams and Healthy Me.
