

Y3and Y4 Topic homework for the Spring term 2018

Dear Parents,

Our Geography topic is Rivers and we would like the children to choose a famous river which they would like to research.

During the week after half term (week beginning), the children will be asked to do a short presentation (3-4 minutes) on a world river. The projects must be brought into school on Tuesday 20th February.

The form/type of presentation is to be decided by the child but they need to be able to talk about it and answer questions, not just read something out or show a power point, although either or both can be used for support or illustration.

Possible components:

Information about

- Location in the world
- Length / size
- Country of source
- Related sports/hobbies/occupations e.g. fishing
- Wildlife
- Conservation

Illustrations

- Photos
- Maps
- Drawings
- Diagrams

All the information can be written or word processed, put on a power point or on large card (poster), or be notes in a folder.
