Dear parents,

During the week after half term (week beginning 22nd February), the children will be asked to do a short presentation (3-4 minutes) on a country.

Our Geography topic is Map Skills and we would like the children to choose a country they would like to research. It could be a country they used to live in, a country your family is from, a country they have visited (on a holiday etc) or it could be a country they would like to know more about.

The form/type of presentation is to be decided by the child but they need to be able to talk about it and answer questions, not just read something out or show a powerpoint, although either or both can be used for support or illustration.

Possible components:

Information about

- Location in the world
- Capital city
- Language spoken
- Personal comments based on a visit/holiday
- Type of coast line/beach
- Related sports/hobbies/occupations e.g. fishing
- Weather/Seasons
- Wildlife
- Conservation

Illustrations

- Photos
- Maps
- Drawings
- Diagrams

All the information can be written or word processed, put on a power point or on large card, or be notes in a folder.
